Today's readings challenge us to choose freely and wisely in order to observe the laws given us by a loving and caring God. God revealed His laws through Moses and the prophets in the Old Testament and through His own Son, Jesus, in the New Testament.

ACTION! Pro-suicide campaigners are lobbying MPs to use what is known as the Parliament Acts to bypass the House of Lords and force the Assisted Suicide Bill into law in the next Parliamentary session. Such use of the Parliament Acts to bypass the Lords' scrutiny of a Private Members' Bill is wholly inappropriate, and would be its first such usage.
