CARE NOT KILLING - APPEAL: The Assisted Suicide Bill comes to the Lords on 12th September. Disappointingly, MPs voted the Bill through the Commons by 314 to 291 at its Third Reading in June. The priority now is for a seasoned political adviser to operate at Westminster (£20,000) to walk peers through the Bill and alert them to its many pitfalls and dangers.
