

**AND A FINAL THOUGHT**: Today is *'BATTLE OF BRITAIN SUNDAY'* and marks the 84th anniversary of the remarkable victory by Royal Air Force pilots and aircrew during the Battle of Britain in September 1940. This was the first decisive battle in history fought entirely in the air, and was a dramatic turning point in the Second World War. *'Never in the field of human conflict was so much owed by so many to so few'*. (Sir Winston Churchill)
