LITURGICAL SYMBOLISM: The lights of the candles on the Advent Wreath dispel the darkness, anticipating the Light of Christ at Christmas. The evergreens are a reminder of continuous life, and their circular form points to eternal life in Christ. The four candles mark the Sundays of Advent. The purple candles remind us of the penitential nature of the season to prepare us for the second coming of Christ. The pink candle (for Gaudete, 3rd Sunday) announces a day of rejoicing as Christ approaches. The white candle in the centre represents Christ himself, and is lit to celebrate the incarnation of the Light of the World.
