**'CARE – NOT KILLING' PETITION:** All MPs will vote on the amended Assisted Suicide Bill at the Third Reading in late April or early May. 142 MPs who voted in favour of the Bill at 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading in November could change their vote at 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading because of concerns over so-called safeguards.

Those concerns include dropping the requirement that a High Court judge must look at every assisted death application on a case-by-case basis - a key reason why many MPs voted for the Bill last November. **By signing the Petition, Catholics in England and Wales can impress upon their MPs how dangerous this Bill is while there's still time.** Sign the petition at <https://carenotkilling.uk/petition>
