New English Cardinal: Fr Timothy Radcliffe OP will become a Cardinal together with 21 others on 8th December. Opposing Assisted Suicide: The House of Lords debated the Assisted Dying Bill on 22nd Oct. The Bill to legally permit doctors and nurses who consent to end the life of the terminally ill, is in danger of passing in law before the end of the year. This may pressurise the vulnerable to end their lives for fear of being a burden and destroy patient trust.
